

FAMILY PROGRAM

The Family Program at Cornerstone consists of eight weeks of education and process groups. We believe that chemical dependency is a disease that affects the entire family. If you have a family member or significant other in treatment, you are strongly encouraged to attend the Family Program. Statistics show that when the family is involved in the treatment process, the success rate for recovery is much higher.

We have expanded the current Family Program due to many requests from family members and concerned persons wishing to have an opportunity to receive education on addictions, as well as time for sharing issues and concerns. This additional group meets on Tuesday evenings. *The resident will not be in attendance*.

Topics will include the disease concept, coping with the effects of addiction, and stumbling blocks in recovery.

Family members are welcome to continue to attend the Tuesday evening program for the full eight week process after the alcoholic or addict has completed outpatient or residential treatment.
